

## Podcast Device Cdrom Instalation

Here are some basic steps that you should follow if you install the Podcast CD:

1. Insert the CD and wait for it to boot, you will see the boxpopuli logo page where it will give you several options for installation. You want to choose "Install from Podcast in a Box". If you don't see this screen, then you are not booting from the CD, so you want to check if the CD is correctly inserted and plugged in...
2. After you read and accept the License, you will be logged in to Podcast Device settings.
  - In the Audio section, select sound card to check for a signal. Watch for the boxes that explain the progress of configuration and click OK on each one of them or press the "Enter" key on your keyboard if the mouse didn't work. Select the sound card and continue to press OK to configure it. If it asks you to look for ISA sound cards it means no sound card was detected, if so you may need to replace the sound card with a different one and try the installation again.
3. "Run sound mixer" in the Audio section. This is optional, you can also set the volume and whether to use line-in or mic at any time after the system is installed, using the web admin "Levels" page.
  - Press the "Tab" key on your keyboard to go from Playback to Capture view mode in the "Sound Mixer" screen.
  - Press on the right arrow key on your keyboard multiple times until you get to the "Capture" button, rise it up to 80% preferably by pressing on the up arrow key on your keyboard.
  - In the Line button, hit the space bar to capture.
  - ESC to exit the sound mixer.
4. The "Network" section is to test if the network is working, select DHCP and the server will determine the IP address, netMask, gateway and DNS info. If it takes long time to locate it, then check your network if it's plugged on. Or if you don't have DHCP on your network, use Static configuration for fixed IP addresses and enter all the settings.
5. USB section is to test and Configure if the thumbdrive is working, simply insert the USB to start capturing a podcast episode, then remove the drive to stop and publish the file. If nothing showed up when you insert the USP thumb drive, then check if the speaker is installed, or try a blank USB key where some of them could come with special files that could confuse the software, or USB card might not be supported.
6. Select your time zone in the "Time" section.

7. Choose a password in the "install" section. The SSH and the Web admin are required to be filled out. the difference between the two is:

Web admin allows you to configure sound, look at episodes, access Archives, listen to live stream...

SSH admin is more advaced for linux users, you can access command lines, log in as root, help you debug. Its is very helpful if you choose a password for it in order to get the support from our technitians if something goes wrong.

the OEM Customization is optional.

8. Click on "install" the Podcast Device at the bottom of this page.

you can click on "playing games" while you are waiting for the installation to complete 😊 .

9. Then it will automatically takes you to the "Reboot" section after it finishes the installation. here you will need to restart your computer.
